

## CECIL G. LAYMAN, JR. SCHOLARSHIP

### Description

Cecil G. Layman, retired principal from Riverheads High School, created this scholarship at the Community Foundation in 1999 to provide funds for college scholarships to outstanding seniors at Riverheads High School who plan to pursue a career in the **field of education**.

### Eligibility

- An eligible student must be a graduating senior at Riverheads High School.
- An eligible student must plan to pursue a career in the field of education.
- An eligible student must be a candidate for high school graduation at the end of the current academic year and plan to enroll at an accredited college or university in the Continental United States the following academic year.

### Selection Criteria

- Merit is the only criteria to be considered
  - Merit is based upon the individual's scholastic achievement, extra-curricular and leadership activities during high school. The student selected must be outstanding in all areas of the foregoing and exhibit standards of good conduct and high moral values.
- The candidate will be selected by the Riverheads High School scholarship selection committee for recommendation to the Community Foundation, in accordance with the Community Foundation's Conflict of Interest Policy.
