



MARTIN LIGHTSEY SCHOLARSHIP FOR TECHNICAL EDUCATION

The Martin Lightsey Scholarship for Technical Education was established to honor Martin Lightsey and all he achieved in the creation and subsequent success of Specialty Blades, Inc. (Cadence, Inc.), upon his stepping down as CEO of the company in 2002.

Description

The Martin Lightsey Scholarship for Technical Education was established in 2002 to provide funds for college scholarships to outstanding seniors residing in Staunton, Waynesboro and Augusta County, who intend to pursue or are currently pursuing **technical education** at the college or community college level.

Eligibility

- An eligible student must reside in Staunton, Waynesboro, or Augusta County.
- An eligible student must demonstrate outstanding academic achievement, financial need, community service and leadership ability.
- An eligible student must plan to further his/her education in a **technical field**.
- An eligible student must be a candidate for high school graduation at the end of the current academic year and plan to enroll at an accredited two-year or four-year college or university in the continental United States the following academic year.

Selection Criteria

- Academic Merit – 60% (scholastic achievement and leadership activities during the high school years.)
- Financial need – 20%
- Community service activities– 20%
- The candidate will be selected by a Community Foundation appointed scholarship selection committee for recommendation to the Community Foundation, in accordance with the Community Foundation's Conflict of Interest Policy.

2010 Award Amount
