

PAUL FLANAGAN SCHOLARSHIP

The Paul Flanagan Scholarship was established by employees of the former King's Daughters' Hospital to honor long-time administrator, Paul Flanagan. He was a faithful member of St. Francis of Assisi Catholic Church in Staunton for 52 years and very active in the civic life of his community.

Description

The Paul Flanagan Scholarship was established to provide funds for college scholarships to outstanding seniors attending Robert E. Lee High School, who plan to further their education in the **health care field** for at least one additional year.

Eligibility

- An eligible student shall be a graduating senior at Robert E. Lee High School.
- An eligible student must plan to further his/her education in the **health care field**.
- An eligible student must be a candidate for high school graduation at the end of the current academic year and plan to continue his/her education for a minimum of one additional year in the Continental United States the following academic year.

Selection Criteria

- Plans to further his/her education in the **health care field**
- The candidate will be selected by the R.E. Lee High School scholarship selection committee for recommendation to the Community Foundation, in accordance with the Community Foundation's Conflict of Interest Policy.
